**RESOLUTION NO. 7790**

Pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code , the Local Government Code (Republic Act No. 7160), Republic Act Nos. 7166 and 9054, and other election laws, the Commission on Elections **RESOLVED** to adopt, as it hereby **RESOLVES** to adopt, the following Calendar of Activities and Periods of Prohibited Acts for the January 13, 2007 plebiscite to ratify the merger of Barangays Calabuso North and Calabuso South, Tagaytay City, into a barangay to be known as Barangay Calabuso, to wit:

**PLEBISCITE DAY**

1. Cockfighting, and other forms of gambling, holding fairs, boxing and/or other similar sports.(sec. 261 (dd) OEC)

2. Giving, accepting free transportation, food, drinks, and things of value. (Sec. 89, OEC).
3. Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving or taking intoxicating liquor etc. (Sec. 261 (dd) (1), OEC).
4. Opening of booths or stalls for the sale of merchandise, refreshment, etc. within 30 meters radius from polling place. (Sec. 261 (dd) (2) OEC).

**PLEBISCITE PERIOD**

Let this Resolution be published by the Education and Information Department (EID), one in a newspaper of general circulation, and one in a newspaper with local circulation in Tagaytay City. The Deputy Executive Director for Operations shall furnish the Regional Election Director of Region IV; the Provincial Election Supervisor of Cavite; the Election Officer of Tagaytay City; the Secretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government; the Secretary of the Department of Education; the Provincial Governor of Cavite; the City Mayor , the City Treasurer and the DepEd District Superintendent of Tagaytay City, with a copy of this Resolution.

The Election Officer of Tagaytay City shall give this Resolution the widest publication in Tagaytay City.

This resolution shall take effect upon its promulgation.
